



2.6.2 - Attainment of Programme outcomes and course outcomes are evaluated by the institution.

The college has a systematic process of evaluating the attainment of Programme outcomes and course outcomes. The level of attainment of Programme Outcomes, Programme Specific Outcomes and Course Outcomes by the students are measured by using the following parameters. The key indicators of measuring attainment are:

1. End Semester University Examination:

Being an affiliated college of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, the students of Thiruvalluvar College are required to take examinations as per the semester and annual pattern set by the university, through which the institution measures programme outcomes based on the course attainment level fixed by the programme.

2. Internal Assessment:

The Internal Assessment constitutes 25% weightage of the total marks (100) in each subject. The students are tested in the format called CIA designed by the college.

3. Practical Assessment / External Assessment:


It is evaluated by external examiners conducting Practical examinations, and taking Viva-Voce.

4. Result Analysis:

At the end of each semester, result analysis of each course is carried out to assess the attainment of Programme outcomes and course outcomes attained by the students.


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
